## **Memento Urn Important Notes**

Store and display the Memento Urn with the protective covering on. Keep the custom packaging that you receive with the Memento Urn. It is a convenient way to transport the urn.

Always place the cremated remains into the biodegradable plastic bag provided with each Memento Urn – **DO NOT** place cremated remains directly into the Memento Urn.

To close the Memento Urn, squeeze a bead of biodegradable glue around the inside of the opening. Place the cap into the opening and apply light pressure for two to three minutes until the glue is dry. Wipe away any excess glue with a clean damp cloth.

All federal and local regulations must be followed when placing this urn in water. This urn should **NOT** be used in protected or restricted waters. It should also **NOT** be placed into the water from the beach/pier.

For water burial, place the Memento Urn on the water's surface with the top facing upward. The Memento Urn is designed to float briefly before gracefully sinking. Float times may vary depending on the weight of the cremated remains and the local water/weather conditions. When placed into earth or water this urn will break down naturally over time.
