Serenity™ Collection **Biodegradable Urns for Water Burial** **Important Notes**

Store and display the Serenity Urn with the lid and base securely attached to each other. The box (and urn) will pass through airport security screenings and can fit into the overhead compartment of most commercial airliners.



The Serenity Urn is crafted by hand from recycled paper and paper clay. Each urn is hand painted and will differ in appearance from other Serenity Urns. Included with each urn is a biodegradable bag into which the cremains **MUST** be placed. **DO NOT** place cremated remains directly into the Serenity Urn.

To close the urn, firmly secure the two halves with the leather cord provided. Step-by-step instructions are located on the other side of this page.

For water burial, place the Serenity Urn onto the water's surface with the top facing up. The Serenity Urn is designed and engineered to briefly float and gracefully sink. The time each Serenity takes to sink will vary depending on the local conditions, and the weight and volume of the cremated remains.

All federal and local regulations must be followed when placing this urn in water. This urn should **NOT** be used in protected or restricted waters. It should also **NOT** be placed into the water from the beach/pier.

Opening, Filling & Closing the Urn


- 1) Your Serenity Urn will arrive carefully packaged and tightly secured. To open, untie the loosely-tied leather cord on one side, and lift the top off the bowl. Leave the other side securely tied.



- 2) Included with each urn is a biodegradable bag into which the cremains **MUST** be placed. Load the biodegradable bag containing the cremated remains into the urn. **DO NOT** place cremated remains directly into the Serenity Urn.
- 3) Close the top of the bowl, lacing the leather cord through the holes and securing as shown.

- 4) Clip off any excess leather cord using sharp scissors.
